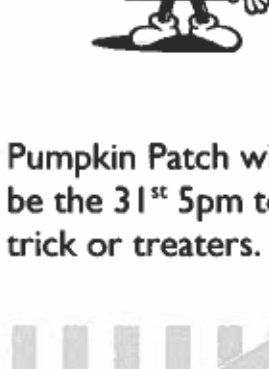

On March 15, 1919 members of the American Expeditionary Force convened a caucus, in Paris, to try and bring back to their hometowns the service to community they all participated in, as they were rebuilding Europe.

The driving force at this and subsequent meetings was their commitment to Community Service. The world was changing drastically, monarchies had fallen, communism had gained its first country, war was seen as obsolete, and standing government's last fear was revolution. Thus, the future Legionnaires worked with our U.S. Congress to establish a non-political organization of Veterans with limited membership.

The American Legion has matured over the decades and championed many Veteran causes, but at its heart still remains that commitment to Community Service. Congress recently passed the American Legion Bill making **all Veterans** since December 7, 1941 eligible to join the American Legion. So, if you like us and believe an American Legion Post is an asset to the local community, please come join us on the First Tuesday of each month, 7:00 P.M. at the VFW Annex Room. The Annex is a non-smoking, non-alcohol meeting room, accessed by the door on the left after entering the enclosed porch.



Do Miracles Occur Today?

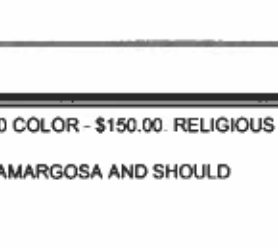
As a Christian, I believe that God has worked miraculously throughout history to point people to the good news about Jesus Christ (Hebrews 2:4). But do miracles still occur today? I believe that they do. In his book *The Case for Miracles* author Lee Strobel documents several healings which I believe can only be explained by divine intervention. One example Strobel gives is that of Duane Miller who lost his voice when a flu virus damaged his vocal cords so he had to resign from his job as the Pastor of the First Baptist Church of Brenham, TX. But then on January 17, 1993, while reading Psalm 103:3 for a Sunday School class at the First Baptist Church of Houston, TX, God restored his voice to perfect health. You can listen to the audio of the moment God gave him his voice back at www.nvvoice.org.

Or consider the case of Delia Knox who was paralyzed from the waist down for 22 years after a car accident on Christmas Day, 1987. But God miraculously healed her at a revival service in 2010. The video of her healing is available online. Or consider the story of Barbara Cummins Snyder who was blind and bedridden after suffering from multiple sclerosis for over 15 years. But one day in 1981, she heard a voice saying, "My child, get up and walk." She obeyed the voice by jumping out of bed and was restored to perfect health. The story is told by Dr. Thomas Marshall in the book *Physician's Untold Stories* by Scott Kolbaba.

Then there are the miracles which occurred in the life of the Chinese Pastor Brother Yun who tells the story in his book *The Heavenly Man* about how he escaped from Zhengzhou Prison by walking out the front door when God caused him to appear invisible to the guards. There are also hundreds of examples of Muslims who have been brought to faith in Christ after receiving dreams and visions about Jesus. One example is Nabeel Qureshi who tells his own story in his book *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus*. I encourage you to investigate the evidence for yourself online and through *The Case for Miracles*.
