Dear Secretary Haaland and Directors Stone-Manning, Williams, and Sams,

On behalf of the Amargosa Valley Town Board, I extend my gratitude for your leadership and efforts to advance the requested Amargosa Valley Mineral Segregation and Withdrawal. We respectfully urge you to formally initiate this process before the end of the current administration to address the imminent and growing threats posed by proposed and potential mining and exploration projects. These activities jeopardize not only the globally significant biological resources but also the wellbeing of the people who live in and cherish this region.

The Ash Meadows National Wildlife Refuge and the Devils Hole unit of Death Valley National Park are integral to the identity, economy, and environmental health of the Amargosa Valley. Protecting these areas is not just a matter of conservation but also one of ensuring the long-term sustainability and quality of life for our community. Mining activities in close proximity to these areas would threaten the fragile balance of our ecosystem, our water resources, and the unique cultural and natural heritage that defines our valley.

We stand in strong support of the science-based map that has been carefully crafted, publicly vetted, and formally endorsed by Senators Cortez Masto and Rosen, Representatives Horsford, Lee, and Titus, Nye County, Nye County Water District, the town boards of Amargosa Valley and Beatty, and numerous conservation organizations. This map, which accompanied the Nevada congressional delegation's letter to Secretary Haaland on July 2, 2024, reflects a thoughtful and balanced approach that protects people, water, wildlife, and our community's shared values.

We recognize that the NEPA process will allow for full consideration, through a public and transparent process, of the options for how best to protect this region for people and the environment. However, from a good government standpoint, it is essential that we follow through with the agreed-upon map that was locally approved and submitted by the Nevada delegation. This map represents a consensus built through collaboration and reflects the collective wisdom and priorities of our community and stakeholders.

It is important to note that the Amargosa Valley Town Board voted to approve this map in a public meeting following proper public notice. This meeting provided an open and transparent opportunity for all interested parties to participate in the decision-making process. The approved map is the result of this inclusive process and should serve as the foundation for advancing the requested segregation and withdrawal.

The residents of Amargosa Valley, along with our elected representatives and conservation partners, remain united in our support for this urgent action. The preservation of Ash Meadows, Devils Hole, and the surrounding region is vital for the long-term health of our community and the environment that sustains us all.

We thank you for your leadership and dedication to protecting this remarkable landscape. We look forward to continuing our engagement in the NEPA process to ensure that all perspectives and values are fairly considered. As a critical next step, we urge the Bureau of Land Management to adopt the science-based map referenced in the July 2, 2024, letter as the analysis area and initiate the segregation of these lands under the NEPA process.
